

By entering the Discovery Space you agree to the following Conditions of Entry. You agree to listen and follow the directions and instructions of the Discovery Space employees and volunteers.

You understand that failure to comply may result in a request to vacate the facility or being denied entry. All adults must be accompanied by at least one child. All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times. For all groups, we suggest a minimum ratio of 1 adult per 5 children. School groups should follow the required ratio of teachers and caregivers approved by their principal.

Running is not permitted in the Discovery Space. Shoes must be worn at all times. Take reasonable care of your own health and safety and ensure you and your child/children in your care do not adversely affect the safety of others or cause any damage to property at the Discovery Space. Visitors, (or in the case of children, the adult accompanying a child/children) will be liable for any damage caused to Discovery Space property and premises resulting from the visitor's conduct.

Food and drink are only to be consumed in designated areas (Discovery Gardens & Café). Hot beverages are to be consumed only in the Café or the Discovery Gardens. Smoking is prohibited in the Discovery Space (including outside gardens) and on the University campus. Visitors must not consume, use or bring alcohol or illegal substances into the Discovery Space.

In the event that attendance exceeds capacity as deemed by management, visitors may be required to wait before gaining access. Please report all incidents and accidents to a Discovery Space employee immediately. We do not carry medication (including Epipen and asthma relievers).

Please dispose of all rubbish, recycling, nappies etc. in the appropriate bins provided. The Discovery Space is not responsible for any lost, stolen or left behind items. Lost property will be sent to UOW security and held for 7 days after which any unclaimed items will be donated to charity. Vehicles in the Early Start basement carpark are parked at your own risk. We will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any vehicle. We can't guarantee a germ-free environment - if you or your child/children become unwell during your visit, please notify a Discovery Space employee or volunteer.

### PHOTOGRAPHS AND RECORDINGS - PRIVACY NOTICE

Visitors are welcome to take photographs and video recording of themselves and their children during their visit. Please respect the privacy of other visitors when taking photographs or videos. Any photographs and video recordings taken by visitors should be for personal use only. Visitors may be photographed or have video footage of themselves and their dependents taken by Discovery Space employees. ## COVID-19 Discovery Space Conditions of Entry

In addition to Australian government regulations and COVID-19 the following Conditions of Entry have been added until further notice:

### Face Masks:

The safety and wellbeing of our customers is our top priority. From Sunday 3 January 2021, we expect all members and guests visiting the Discovery Space aged 12 years and over to wear a face covering as per the NSW Governments directive. Children aged 12 and under are exempt but are encouraged to wear masks where practicable. This will apply to our team. There may be limited exceptions to this mandatory requirement such as medical conditions and children aged 12 and under. We encourage all members and guests who cannot wear a face covering due to valid medical reasons to consider delaying their visit. We encourage you continue to be COVID safe whilst visiting the Discovery Space. Please use the hand sanitiser available and maintain social distancing.

### Physical distancing.

- Members and guests (inclusive of children under 12 months of age) must pre-book admission online. Daily sessions will operate Tuesday- Sunday with a capacity limit. CLOSED Monday and Public Holidays.
- Session capacity is limited to 100 members and guests inclusive of children under 12 months of age. Excludes staff. Until further notice.
- Please follow signage and markers on the floor at entrances for correct entry and exit flow.
- Where reasonably practical, please respect others and look after your own and your child/children's personal safety by complying with 1.5 metres of physical distance. Reduce crowding wherever possible.
- Please follow signage for experience and encounter recommended capacity limits. Use the hand sanitiser provided before and after use. Reduce crowding wherever possible.

### Hygiene and cleaning

- Symptoms of COVID-19 include fever, cough, sore/scratchy throat and shortness of breath. Other reported symptoms of COVID-19 include loss of smell, loss of taste, runny nose, muscle pain, joint pain, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting and loss of appetite. In more severe cases, infection can cause pneumonia with severe acute respiratory distress.

Anyone with respiratory symptoms (such as cough, sore/scratchy throat or shortness of breath) or unexplained fever should be tested for COVID-19. If you or your child/children's have any of these symptoms or are feeling unwell please do not attend the Discovery Space. If you or your child/children's present with these symptoms entry will be refused.

- Adopt good hand hygiene practices.
- Frequently used areas are cleaned daily with detergent and/or disinfectant. Frequently touched areas and surfaces are cleaned several times per day.
- We only accept contactless payment options. Cash will not be accepted.
- Prior to entry or using equipment please use hand sanitiser provided before and after use.

- All visitors are required to provide a record of name, mobile number and email address prior to entry. Failure to provide these details will result in entry being refused. Records of personal information will be used only for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections and are stored confidentially and securely.
- Please consider the COVIDSafe app and its benefits to support contact tracing if required.
- Stay home if you or anyone in your party are unwell.
- Wash or sanitise yours and your children's hands before entering the Discovery Space and before and during your visit.
- Scan your QR code at the front desk prior to entry.
- Bring a water bottle or you can purchase water from Ugly Duckling café.
- Keep your distance from others as much as possible.
- Follow any instructions from staff with respect to hygiene, cleaning and social distancing.

### COVID-19 HEALTH SCREENING- SELF ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO VISITING

- You do not have any symptoms associated with COVID-19 (e.g. fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, sneezing/runny nose or loss of sense of smell)
- You do not have COVID-19 nor are you awaiting the results from being tested for COVID-19
- You have not been in contact with any known or suspected cases of COVID-19 in the past 14 days
- You have not returned, or been in contact with anyone else who has returned, from overseas in the past 14 days.
