

## Discovery Space Session Tickets Terms and Conditions

### **If you cannot attend your allocated session:**

You can apply for a credit to reschedule to another session at a later date by emailing 1 hour prior to your session time via [discovery-space@uow.edu.au](mailto:discovery-space@uow.edu.au)

For a refund of fees paid we require that you notify us via email 1 hour prior to your session time via email [discovery-space@uow.edu.au](mailto:discovery-space@uow.edu.au) No shows will not be eligible for a refund.

**If I am sick and cannot come to the Discovery Space do I get a refund?** We understand that plans change. We do ask that you call the Discovery Space by the morning of your visit date to let us know that you won't be visiting so we can release the tickets to another family. We appreciate your cooperation and courtesy as we try to meet visitor demand during this low-capacity period.

**Do I need to make a reservation for my child under age 1?** Yes. To enter the Discovery Space, all members and general admission visitors need a reservation for everyone in their party to enter, including children under the age of 1. **Note:** children under age 1 will not be charged, but must be included in your party's total reservation count to help monitor visitor capacity.

Please ensure you read the Early Start Discovery Space conditions of entry and outlined session tickets terms and conditions below carefully to avoid disappointment.

1. Prices are valid as per 18 October 2021. All session bookings are 3 hours duration.
2. You can apply for a credit to reschedule to another session at a later date by emailing 1 hour prior to your session time via email [discovery-space@uow.edu.au](mailto:discovery-space@uow.edu.au) For a refund of fees paid we require that you notify us via email 1 hour prior to your session time via email. No shows will not be eligible for a refund.
3. Bookings are essential. You are required to pre book tickets to sessions prior to entering Early Start Discovery Space for all guests in your party including children under 12 months of age. You must enter your name, contact number or email for the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections. Failure to provide contact information details for all guests in your party will result in access being denied.
4. It is the booking holders responsibility to ensure that all guests in the booking comply with the Early Start Discovery Space conditions of entry including COVID screening questions, electronic check in, face mask requirements and guests aged 16 years and older are able to confirm they have had double dose vaccination, until the 1st of December or at a time when more information is released about 90% vaccination rate of adults in NSW.
5. The Early Start Discovery Space reserves the right to update or change the terms and conditions of entry, and membership benefits at any time without prior notice.
6. The Early Start Discovery Space collects & manages your personal information in a professional and responsible manner following the UOW Privacy Principles. The information provided by you will only be used for Early Start Discovery Space purposes, such as the administration of your entry and the purposes of tracing COVID-19 infections. The Early Start Discovery Space will not disclose, sell, distribute, share or otherwise pass on your personal information to any third party.
7. The Early Start Discovery Space shares its space with the greater Early Start and University. Students from the Early Years, Education, Psychology and occasionally other faculties may use the Discovery Space to run activities, practice their skills, observe how spaces are used or how children interact with those spaces. While some observations may be noted, no identifying content will be recorded, nor data collected without your permission.
