

**By entering the Discovery Space you agree to the following Conditions of Entry.**

### **1. When visiting the Discovery Space:**

- You agree to follow the directions and instructions of the Discovery Space staff and volunteers. You understand that failure to comply may result in a request to vacate the facility or being denied entry.
- All adults must be accompanied by at least one child.
- All children must be accompanied and supervised by an adult at all times.
- Please take reasonable care of your own health and safety and ensure you and your child/children in your care do not adversely affect the safety of others or cause any damage to property at the Discovery Space.
- Visitors, (or in the case of children, the adult accompanying a child/children) will be liable for any damage caused to Discovery Space property and premises resulting from the visitor's conduct.
- Food and drink are only to be consumed in designated areas (Discovery Gardens & Café). Hot beverages should be consumed preferably at the Café. If hot beverages are consumed in the Discovery Gardens please make sure that you do not leave the food / drink unattended or allow children to handle them.
- Please dispose all rubbish, recycling, nappies etc. in the appropriate bins provided.

### **2. Payment and Ticketing**

- We only accept contactless payment options. Cash will not be accepted.
- Tickets/bookings are valid only for the specific event or entry for which they have been issued, at the specific date and time period stated on the booking/ticket.
- Please revise our Membership Conditions for further information regarding membership

### **3. Security and Safety**

- The Discovery Space is not responsible for any lost, stolen or left behind items. Lost property will be sent to UOW security and held for 7 days after which any unclaimed items will be donated to charity.
- Please report all incidents and accidents to a Discovery Space employee immediately. We do not carry medication (including EpiPen and asthma relievers).
- Vehicles in the Early Start basement carpark are parked at your own risk. We will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any vehicle.
- Smoking is prohibited in the Discovery Space (including outside gardens) and on the University campus. Visitors must not consume, use or bring alcohol or illegal substances into the Discovery Space.
- In the event that attendance exceeds capacity, visitors may be required to wait for periods of time before gaining access to our space.

#### 4. Photographs and Recording – Privacy Note

- Visitors are welcome to take photographs and video recording of themselves and their children during their visit. Please respect the privacy of other visitors when taking photographs or videos. Any photographs and video recordings taken by visitors should be for personal use only.
- From time to time, visitors may be photographed or have video footage of themselves and their dependents taken by Discovery Space employees. We will seek your permission to use photographs or recordings for specified purposes related to the Discovery Space and UOW in accordance with Discovery Space Privacy Protocols (which are available online at <http://earlystartdiscoveryspace.edu.au/wpcontent/u...> or please ask a Discovery Space employee to see a copy of the Discovery Space Privacy Protocols.

#### 5. Hygiene and cleaning

- We can't guarantee a germ-free environment – if you or your child/children become unwell during your visit, please notify a Discovery Space employee or volunteer.
- If you or your child/children are feeling unwell please do not attend the Discovery Space. This includes, but is not limited to, symptoms of COVID19 which include fever, cough, sore/scratchy throat and shortness of breath. Other reported symptoms of COVID-19 include loss of smell, loss of taste, runny nose, muscle pain, joint pain, diarrhoea, nausea/vomiting and loss of appetite.
- Please use the hand sanitiser provided regularly whilst inside the Discovery Space.
- Please use sanitizing wipe stations provided at your personal discretion.
- We are continuing daily cleaning to support the safety and comfort of all visitors in line with our COVID Safe Business Plan.

#### 6. Additional Conditions of Entry due to COVID-19.

We encourage you to refer back to these Terms regularly as they will continue to be updated to keep our community safe, comply with any future Australian government regulations or NSW Government Public Health Orders. These Conditions of Entry are also subject to change at short notice.

- Face masks are not mandatory, but highly encouraged for all visitors to the Discovery Space.
- Bookings are preferred. Members and guests (inclusive of children under 12 months of age) are encouraged to pre-book admission online.
- Where reasonably practical, please respect others and look after your own and your child/children's personal safety by complying with 1.5 metres of physical distance.

- **When entering, you agree that:**
  - You do not have any symptoms associated with COVID-19 (e.g. fever, cough, sore throat, shortness of breath, sneezing/runny nose or loss of sense of smell)
  - You do not have COVID-19 nor are you awaiting the results from being tested for COVID-19
  - You are not required to self-isolate under NSW Government requirements
